Catch Crop mixtures are becoming increasingly popular as a way of providing quality feed for finishing lambs or maintaining ewes. Most of these new concepts involve the blending of species such as stubble turnips, forage rapes, kales and Italian ryegrass.

- Balanced feed to graze in situ
- Autumn or winter keep
- Improved protein content

### Lamb Tonic

0.50 kg Plantain Tonic  
2.50 kg Chicory  
3.00 kg per acre

A new concept developed in New Zealand. The use of Plantain provides additional mineral content and faster finishing. The crop has the ability to regrow after initial grazing.

### Early Lamb

0.80 kg Forage Rape Hobson  
1.00 kg Stubble Turnip Samson  
0.20 kg Kale Keeper  
2.00 kg per acre

A mixture designed to produce quality feed for finishing lambs or maintaining ewes pre-Christmas.

### Meat Maker

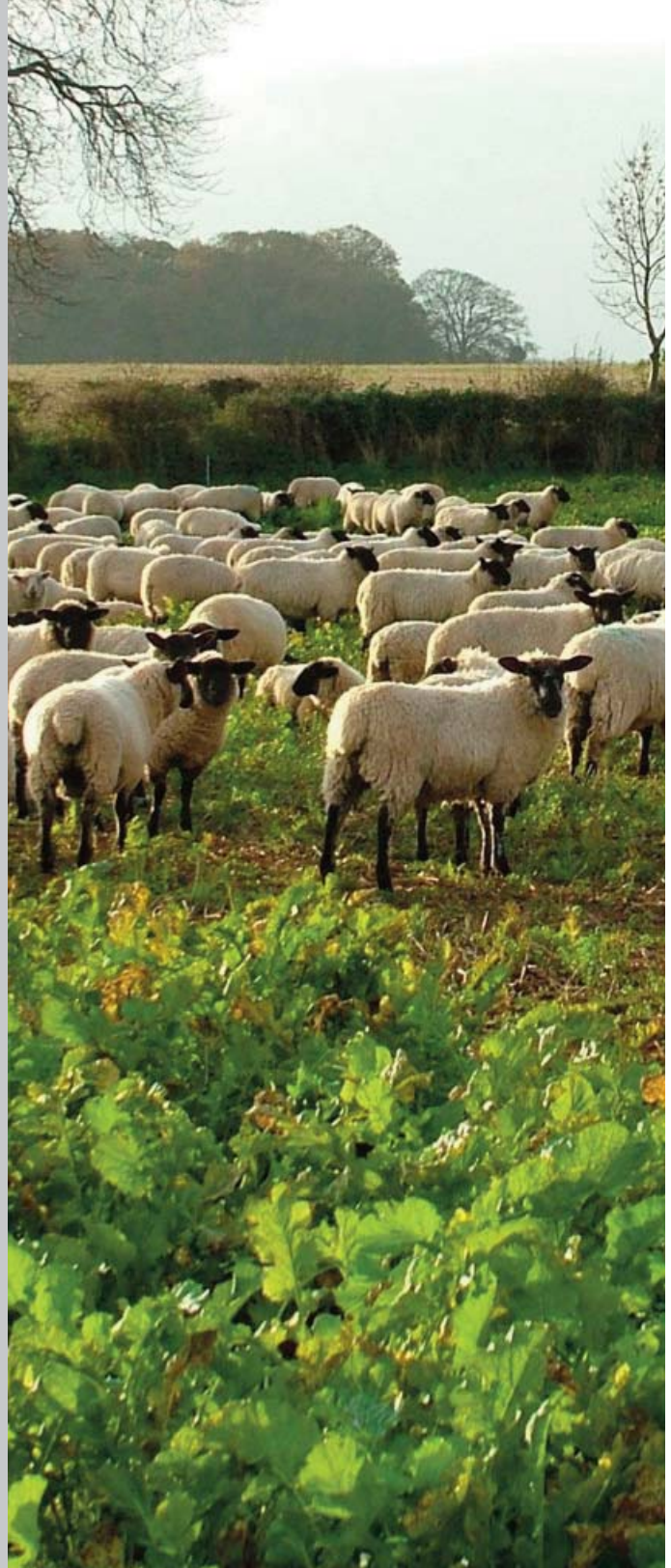
1.30 kg Forage Rape Hobson  
0.50 kg Stubble Turnip Rondo  
0.20 kg Kale Pinfold  
2.00 kg per acre

An excellent blend designed to produce autumn or winter keep from minimal effort.

### Late Lamb

1.00 kg Forage Rape Interval  
1.00 kg Stubble Turnip Rondo  
5.00 kg Italian Ryegrass  
7.00 kg per acre

The inclusion of varieties with improved winter hardiness makes this mixture ideal for later use. Italian Ryegrass ensures the crop has improved density to help prevent dirty animals.
